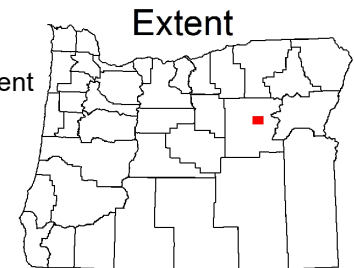

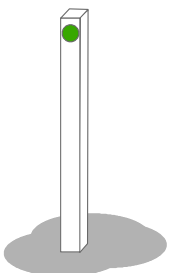
Private Land

Motorized vehicle travel within the Travel Management Area boundary on all other roads and trails, and crosscountry is prohibited except by permit from the Malheur National Forest.

OBJECTIVES:

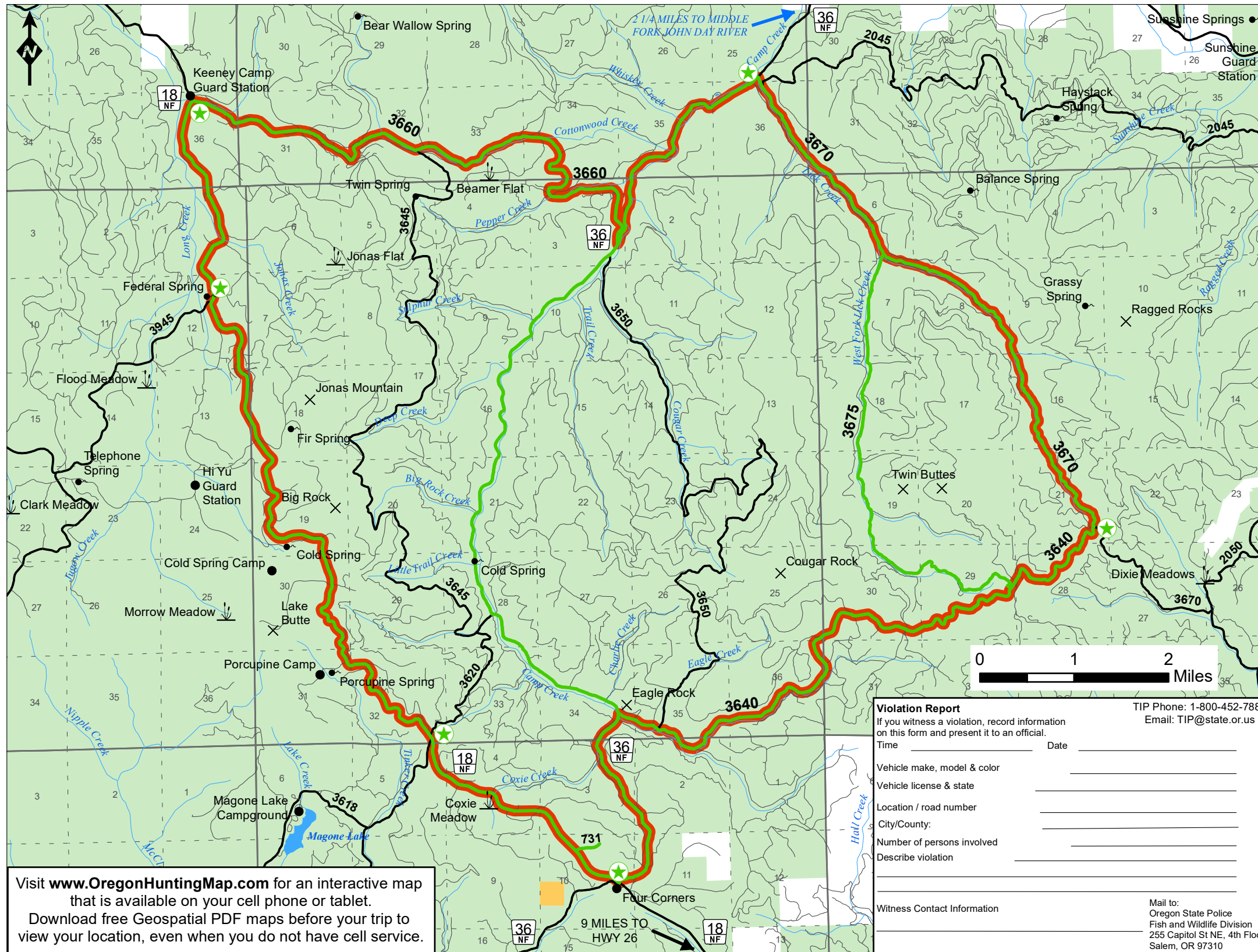
1. Protect soils and wildlife habitat
