BEACH USE



A Wildlife Treasure

Willow Bar Beach (clothed)

Located at milepost 7 on Reeder Road.
Turn right at Multnomah and Columbia
County line.

Beach length: two miles

Walton Beach (clothed)

Located at milepost 9.8 on Reeder Road.

Beach length: one mile.

Collins Beach (clothing-optional)

Located at milepost 11 on Reeder Road,
one-quarter mile north of the end of
pavement.

Beach length: one mile.

*Clothing optional users: Please stay within
the posted boundaries of Collins Beach
(1400 feet south of private property signs) -
you do not want to lose the privilege to use
this beach.*

North Unit Beach (clothed)

Located at milepost 13 on Reeder Road,
two and one-quarter miles north of the end
of pavement.

Beach length: three miles.

Regulations

*Please obey Sauvie Island Wildlife
Area Regulations for your safety and
wildlife habitat protection.*

- No open fires are allowed.
- All dogs must be on leashes and under control of owner.
- No motor-powered vehicles are allowed on beaches except emergency or service vehicles.
- Discharge of firearms is allowed only during authorized hunting seasons.

Hours

Sauvie Island Wildlife Area Beaches
are open from 4 AM to 10 PM every
day.

Parking Revenue

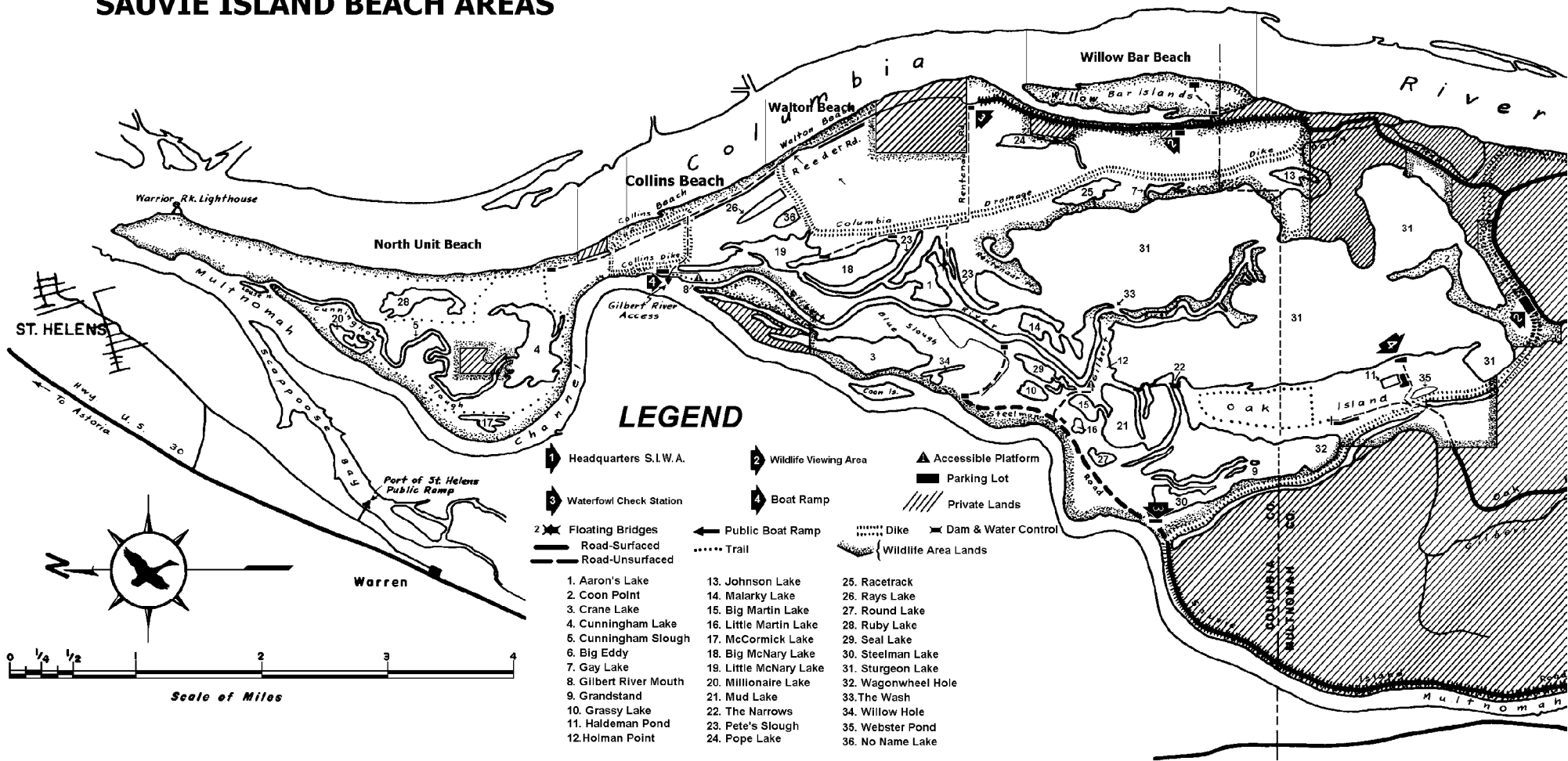
Parking permit revenue provides for

Enforcement

Beaches are patrolled daily by
Columbia County, Multnomah County,
Oregon State Police and Oregon
Department of Fish and Wildlife.
