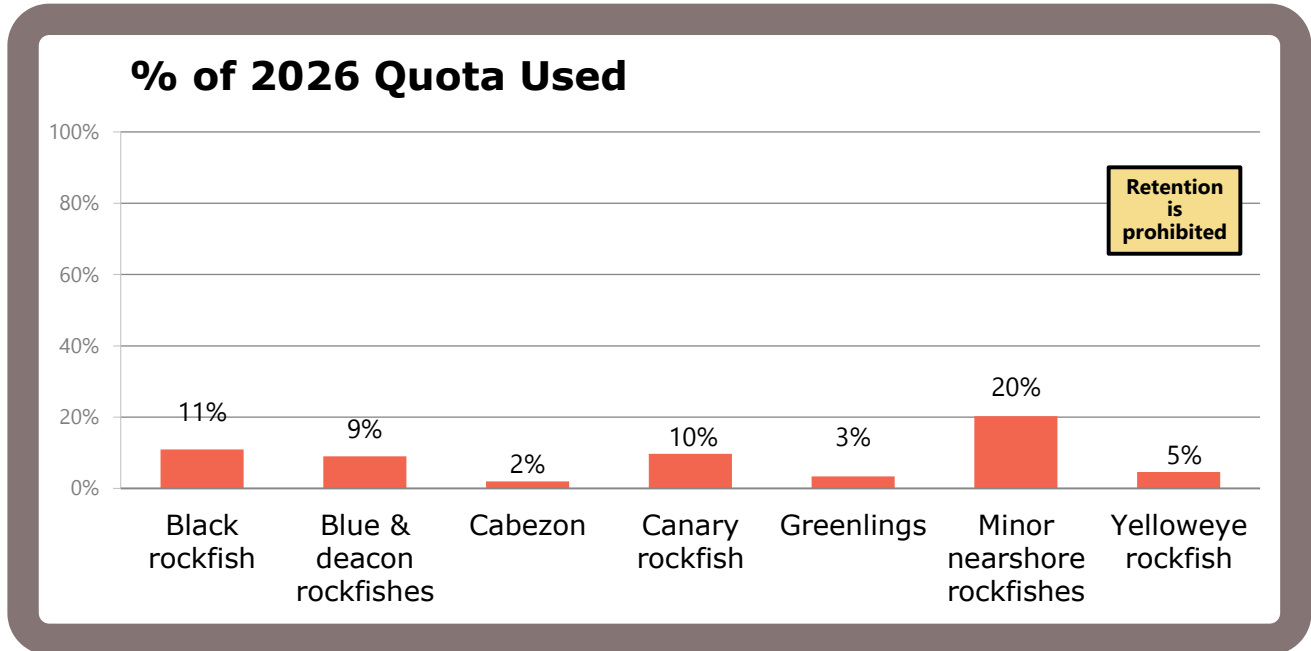




# 2026 RECREATIONAL GROUND FISH QUOTAS

Preliminary through MARCH

Angling regulations might change before 100% of a quota is used, so check for inseason updates before heading out to fish.



*These are groundfish species with a quota that ODFW is required to track and manage.*

**Greenlings** include kelp greenling and rock greenling.

**Minor nearshore rockfishes** include China, copper, quillback, black-and-yellow, brown, calico, gopher, grass, kelp, olive, and treefish rockfishes.

**Yelloweye rockfish** retention is not allowed, but impacts still occur because some fish die after being released. Mortality rates vary by depth and whether or not a descending device was used.
