## **Commercial Nearshore Regulations Effective January 1, 2025**

This notice details regulations for 2025, adopted by the Oregon Fish and Wildlife Commission on December 13, 2024. Notable changes for 2025 include a 33% reduction in the Black Rockfish commercial harvest guideline and associated decreases in Black Rockfish vessel limits due to results of the 2023 federal stock assessment of black rockfish in Oregon waters. Actions taken by the Commission in 2021 prohibited the retention of quillback rockfish for both sport and commercial fisheries and suspended per-trip limits for Black Rockfish Management Areas (BRMAs). In 2022, the suspension of per-trip limits in the BRMAs was extended through 2025 to evaluate impacts. Regulations may change throughout the season to achieve management goals. **Quillback rockfish prohibition: Unlawful to *retain or land* quillback rockfish taken with any non-trawl gear for commercial purposes, regardless of permit type.**

**Black Rockfish Management Areas: Per-trip limits for vessels fishing in these areas are *suspended* through 2025.**

**2-Month Cumulative Trip Limits – No vessel may land more than the following amounts:**

### **Vessels with a Black Rockfish and Blue Rockfish Permit *WITH or WITHOUT* a Nearshore Endorsement**

- Black Rockfish
  - Period 1, January-February: 1,200 pounds
  - Period 2, March-April: 1,200 pounds
  - Period 3, May-June: 1,600 pounds
  - Period 4, July-August: 1,600 pounds
  - Period 5, September-October: 1,200 pounds
  - Period 6, November-December: 1,200 pounds
- Blue and Deacon Rockfish combined: 1,500 pounds per period

### **Vessels with a Black Rockfish and Blue Rockfish Permit *WITHOUT* a Nearshore Endorsement**

- **All other Nearshore Fish species combined:** 15 pounds per day, not to exceed 25% of total landing by weight or cumulative trip limits for permits with a Nearshore Endorsement (below).

### **Vessels with a Black Rockfish and Blue Rockfish Permit *WITH* a Nearshore Endorsement**

- **Other Nearshore Rockfish combined:** 450 pounds per period
- **Cabazon:** 1,500 pounds per period
- **Greenling:** 1,200 pounds per period

\* You must have a Nearshore Endorsement to land more than the incidental amount of tiger and vermilion rockfish. Landings of these species apply toward each fisher’s federal shelf rockfish trip limit, and not toward the state trip limits or annual harvest guidelines.

Initial 2025 federal trip limits for lingcod, canary, widow, and yellowtail rockfish are listed below. It is the responsibility of each fisher to know and comply with federal trip limits that are in effect at any given time.

For the purposes of federal trip limits, only vessels with a federal Pacific Coast Groundfish Limited Entry Permit are considered Limited Entry.

### 2025 Limits with In-season Adjustments

Lingcod	North of 42°00' N	9,000 lb / 2 months	11,000 lb / 2 months
Canary rockfish	North of 40°10' N	1,000 lb / 2 months	3,000 lb / 2 months
Widow rockfish	North of 40°10' N	2,000 lb / 2 months	4,000 lb / 2 months
Yellowtail rockfish	North of 40°10' N	3,000 lb / 2 months	6,000 lb / 2 months
