March 15-Oct. 31

Cape Falcon to OR/CA Border
Open for All Salmon
(Mark Selective coho)

Quota = 120,000 fin-clipped coho

June 12 – Aug. 28

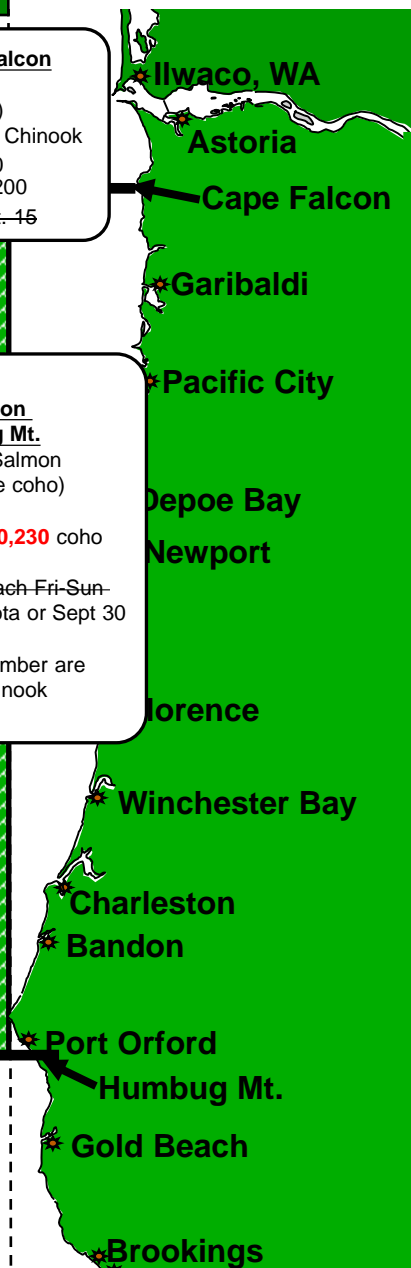
Cape Falcon to Humbug Mt.
Open for All Salmon
(Non Selective coho)







Quota = 44,000 **20,230** coho

Sept. 10-12 and each Fri-Sun
Sept. 17 through quota or Sept 30

All days in September are open for Chinook

Humbug Mt. to OR/CA Border
Mark Selective coho open June 12-Aug 28 or quota
Chinook open June 19-Aug 15
No quota for Chinook



-  All salmon except coho, 1 per day.
-  All salmon, 2 per day only 1 may be a Chinook. All coho must have a healed adipose fin clip.
-  All salmon except coho, 2 per day.
-  All salmon except Chinook, 2 per day.
-  All salmon, 2 per day. All coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. A portion of any remaining mark selective coho quota may be rolled forward to the September non mark selective coho season on an impact neutral basis.
-  All salmon, 2 per day. Open for all salmon (no fin-clip restriction on retained coho).

Other Regulations:

- 1) In the Stonewall Bank Yelloweye Rockfish Cons. Area, salmon fishing is limited to trolling on open "all depth halibut" days.
- 2) No more than 2 single point barbless hooks and one line when fishing for salmon or when a salmon is on board.
- 3) Minimum lengths: Chinook – 22" N. of Falcon and 24" S. of Falcon, coho – 16", steelhead – 20"; no size restriction for pink, chum, or sockeye salmon.
