

2022 Oregon Ocean Salmon Sport Seasons

Statewide Regulations:

- Anglers fishing for salmon and all anglers fishing from boats with a salmon on board are limited to no more than 2 single point barbless hooks per line, and no more than one line per angler
- It is unlawful to fish for or take and retain any legal species while possessing on board any species not allowed to be taken in that area at that time
- Minimum lengths: Chinook: N. of Cape Falcon = 22", S. of Cape Falcon = 24"; coho = 16"; steelhead = 20"; no min. length for pink, chum, or sockeye salmon in ocean fishery
- Refer to the "2022 Oregon Sportfishing Regulations" booklet for descriptions of special marine management areas including closed areas and additional restrictions



Leadbetter Point, WA to Cape Falcon, OR:

Coho Quota = 84,000 fin-clipped coho

Chinook guideline = 7,700 **Season:** June 25- **Aug. 22:** Open for all salmon (all coho must have a healed adipose fin clip). Two salmon per day, but no more than one Chinook.

Aug. 23-Sept 30 or coho quota: Open for marked coho only (all coho must have a healed adipose fin clip). CLOSED to Chinook Salmon.

Notes: Open seven days per week. Closed within the Columbia Control Zone.

Cape Falcon to Humbug Mountain:

Chinook Season (all salmon except coho):

Season: Open March 15 through Oct. 31

Bag Limit: Two salmon per day, closed to retention of coho except as listed below for the "selective coho" and the "non-selective coho" seasons

Selective Coho Season (quota applies to area from Cape Falcon to OR/CA Border):

Season: Open June 18 through earlier of Aug. 21 or 100,000 marked coho quota

Bag Limit: All salmon. Two salmon per day, all coho must have a healed adipose fin clip

Non-selective Coho Season:

Season: Open Sept. 3 through earlier of Sept. 30 or **26,800** non mark selective coho quota

Bag Limit: All salmon. Two salmon per day.

Notes: • Within the Stonewall Bank Yelloweye Rockfish Conservation Area salmon angling is restricted to trolling on all depth halibut days.

- Chinook Season (all salmon except coho) will reopen beginning March 15, 2023 unless modified by in-season action in March 2023

Humbug Mountain to OR/CA Border:

Chinook Season (all salmon except coho):

Season: Open June 25 through August 21

Bag Limit: Two salmon per day, closed to retention of coho except during the mark selective coho season

Mark Selective Coho Season:

Season: Open June 18 through earlier of August 21 or Cape Falcon to OR/CA Border coho quota described above.

Bag Limit: Two salmon per day, all coho must have a healed adipose fin clip (closed to retention of Chinook June 18-24)
