

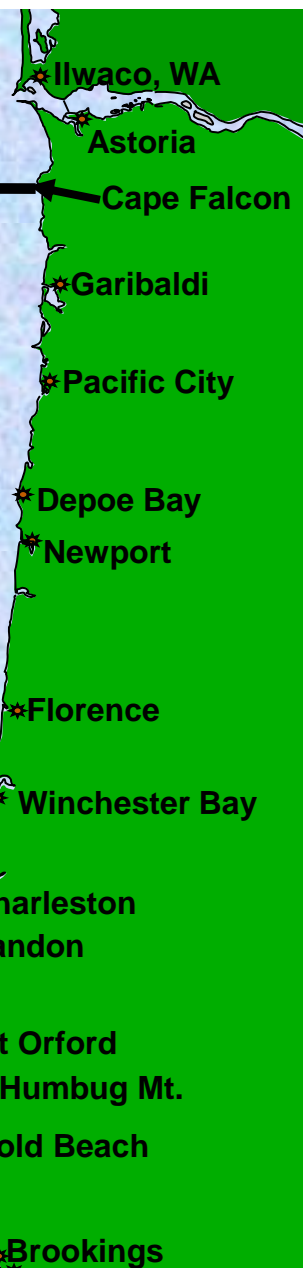
Summary Graphics of the 2023 Ocean Salmon Season Alternatives for Recreational and Commercial Troll Seasons off Oregon as Adopted at the Pacific Fishery Management Council on March 10, 2023

 2 salmon; but no more than 1 Chinook
 Coho Quota = **84,000 fin-clipped coho**
 Chinook Guideline = **12,520**
 June 24-Sept. 30 or quota

Cape Falcon to Humbug Mt.
 Open for All Salmon
 (Non-Selective coho)
 2 salmon per day


 Quota = **25,000 coho**

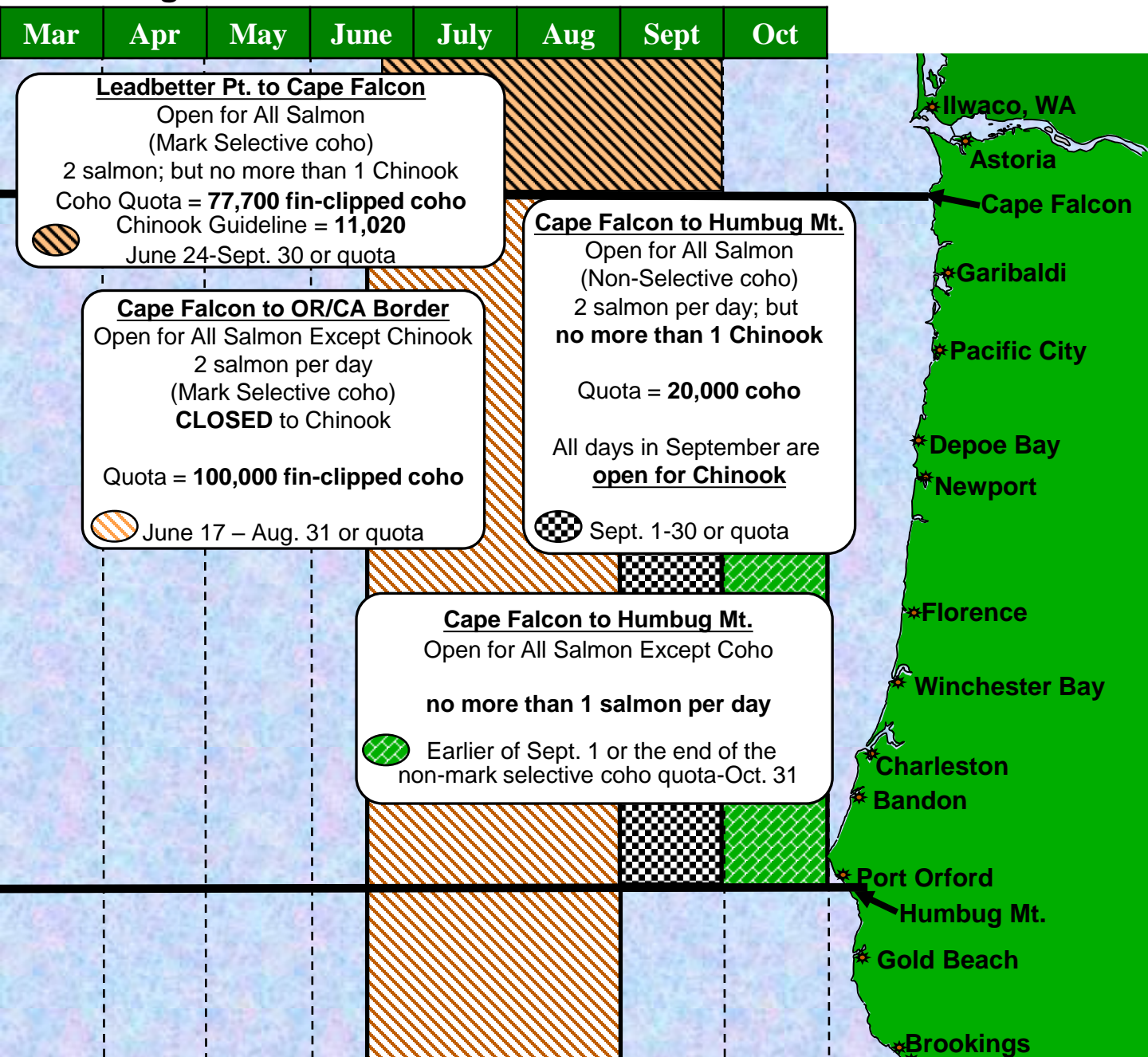

-  All salmon, 2 per day only 1 may be a Chinook. All coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. An impact neutral non-selective coho fishery may be considered through inseason management action later in the season.
-  All salmon except coho, 2 per day.
-  All salmon **except closed for Chinook**, 2 per day. All coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. A portion of any coho remaining from this quota may be rolled forward to the September **commercial troll non-selective coho season** on an impact neutral basis.
-  All salmon, 2 per day. Open for all salmon (no fin-clip restriction on retained coho).

Other Regulations:

- 1) In the Stonewall Bank YRCA, salmon fishing is limited to trolling on open “all depth halibut” days.
- 2) No more than 2 single point barbless hooks and one line when fishing for salmon or when a salmon is on board. Salmon may only be taken using single point barbless hooks.
- 3) Min. lengths: Chinook – 22” N. of Falcon and 24” S. of Falcon, coho – 16”, steelhead – 20”; no size restriction for pink, chum, or sockeye salmon.

Oregon Ocean Recreational Salmon Alternative 2 – 3/10/2023



- All salmon, 2 per day only 1 may be a Chinook. All coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. An impact neutral non-selective coho fishery may be considered through inseason management action later in the season.
 - All salmon, **1 salmon per day**.
 - All salmon **except closed for Chinook**, 2 per day. All coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. A portion of any coho remaining from this quota may be rolled forward to the **September recreational** non-selective coho season on an impact neutral basis.
 - All salmon, **2 per day only 1 may be a Chinook**. Open for all salmon (no fin-clip restriction on coho).
- Other Regulations:
- 1) In the Stonewall Bank YRCA, salmon fishing is limited to trolling on open “all depth halibut” days.
 - 2) No more than 2 single point barbless hooks and one line when fishing for salmon or when a salmon is on board. Salmon may only be taken using single point barbless hooks.
 - 3) Min. lengths: Chinook – 22” N. of Falcon and 24” S. of Falcon, coho – 16”, steelhead – 20”; no size restriction for pink, chum, or sockeye salmon.

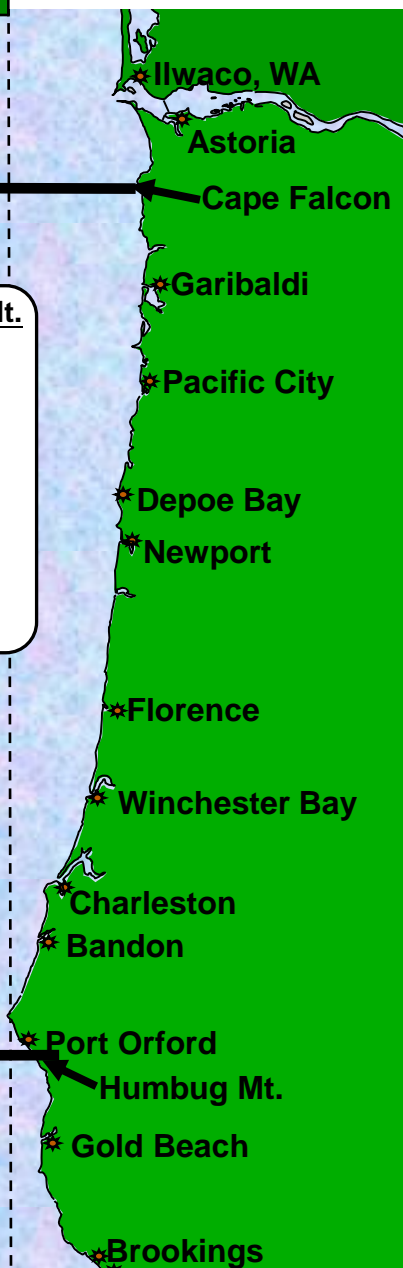

 Quota = 90,000 fin-clipped coho
June 17 – Aug. 31 or quota

Cape Falcon to Humbug Mt.
 Open for All Salmon
 (Non-Selective coho)
 2 salmon per day
CLOSED to Chinook
 Quota = **15,000 coho**
Sept. 1-30 or quota

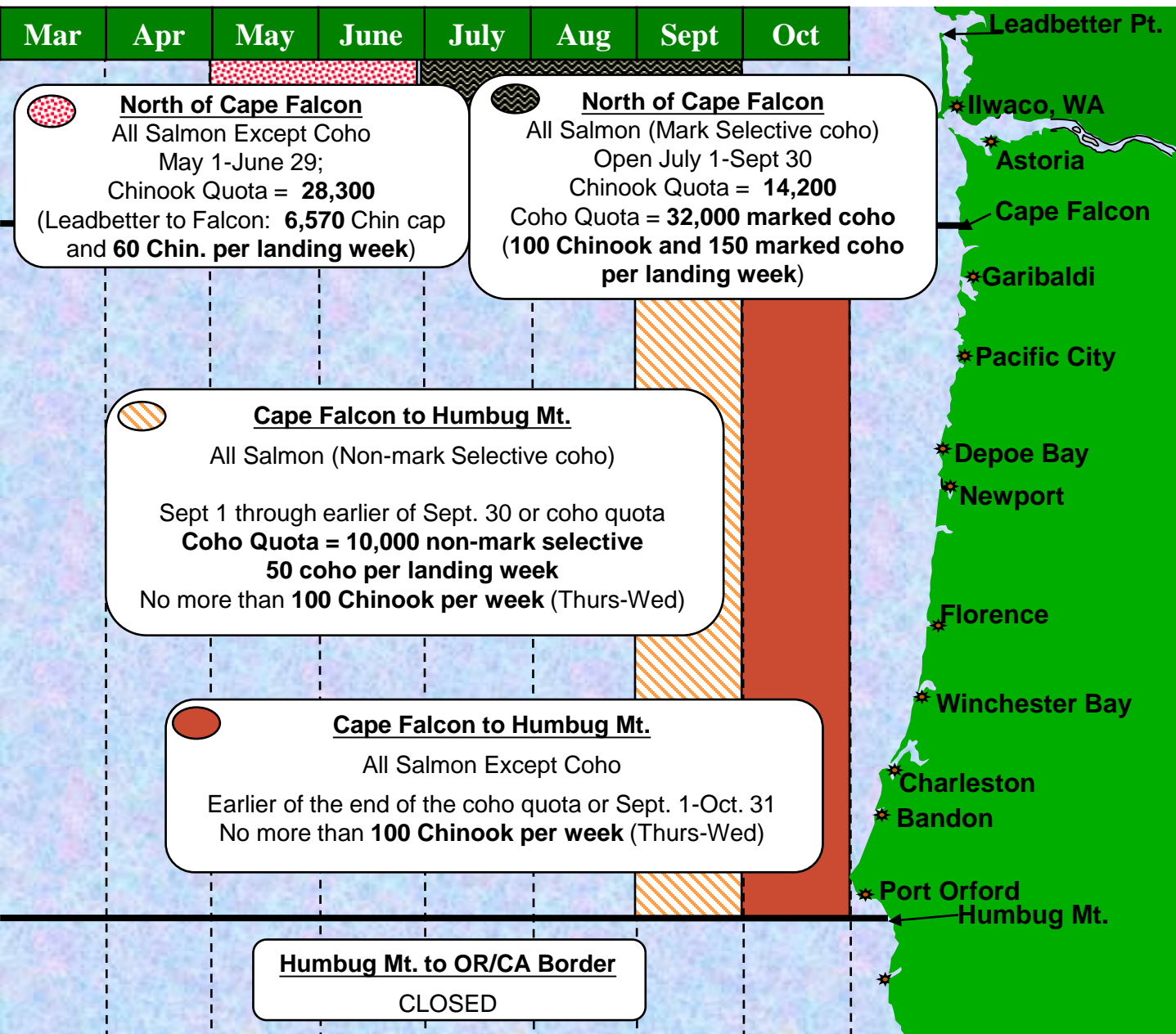

-  All salmon **except closed for Chinook**, 2 per day. All coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. A portion of any coho remaining from this quota may be rolled forward to the **September recreational** non-selective coho season on an impact neutral basis.
-  All salmon **except closed for Chinook**, **2 per day**. No fin-clip restriction on coho.

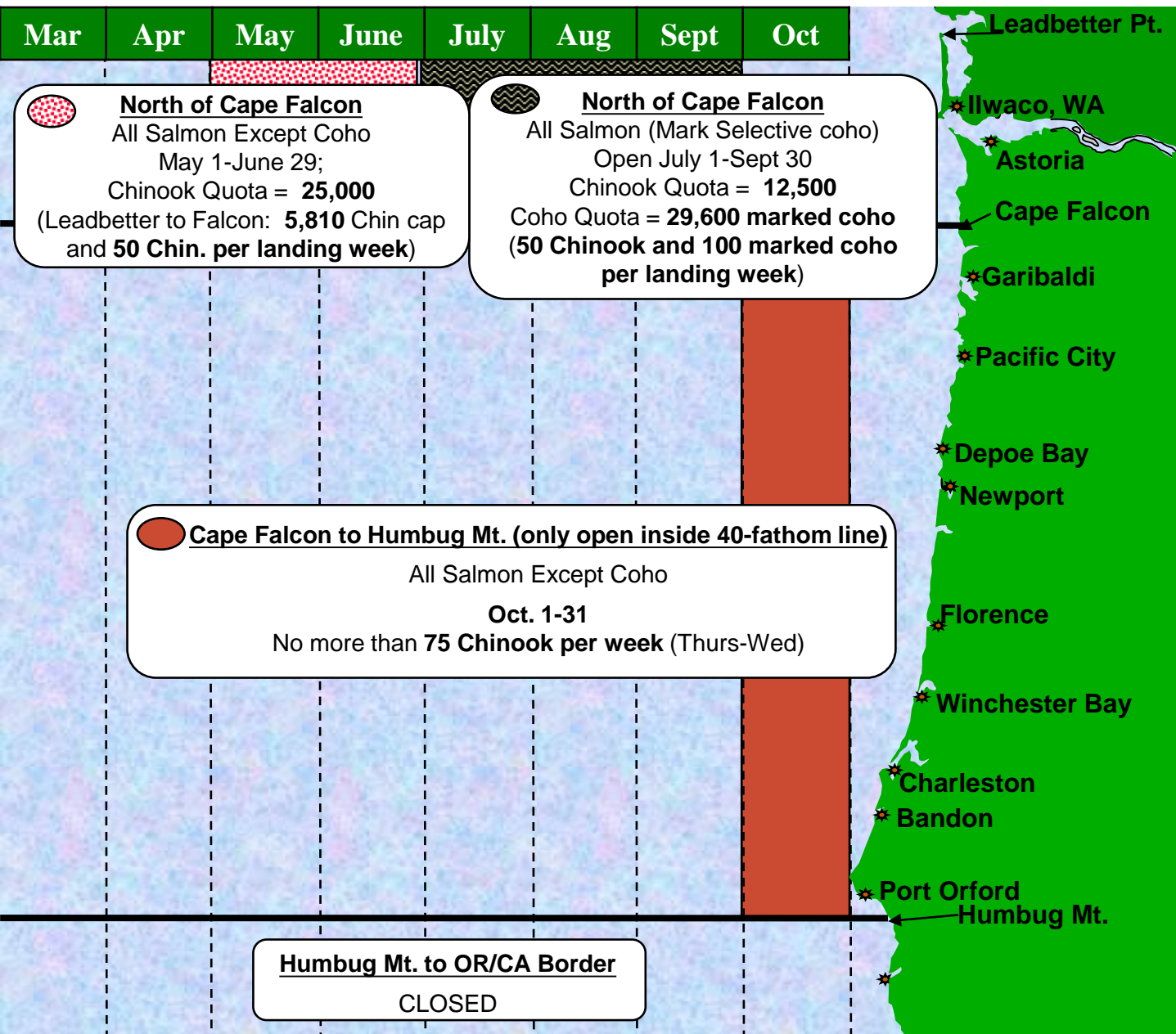

Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Chinook 27" minimum length. All landings into Oregon must be reported within one hour of landing at (541)857-2546 or to nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov Landing week defined as Thursday-Wednesday.
- All salmon, all coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. Vessels landing south of Leadbetter Pt., WA may only fish south of Leadbetter Pt. Vessels fishing north of Leadbetter Pt., must land their catch north of Leadbetter Pt. Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Chinook 27" and coho 16" minimum lengths. - All salmon. No more than 50 coho and 100 Chinook per landing week. Weekly limits may be modified inseason. No more than 4 spreads per wire. Chinook 28" and coho 16" minimum lengths.
- All salmon except coho; 100 Chinook per landing week. All fish must be landed into Oregon. No more than 4 spreads per wire. Chinook 28" minimum length.

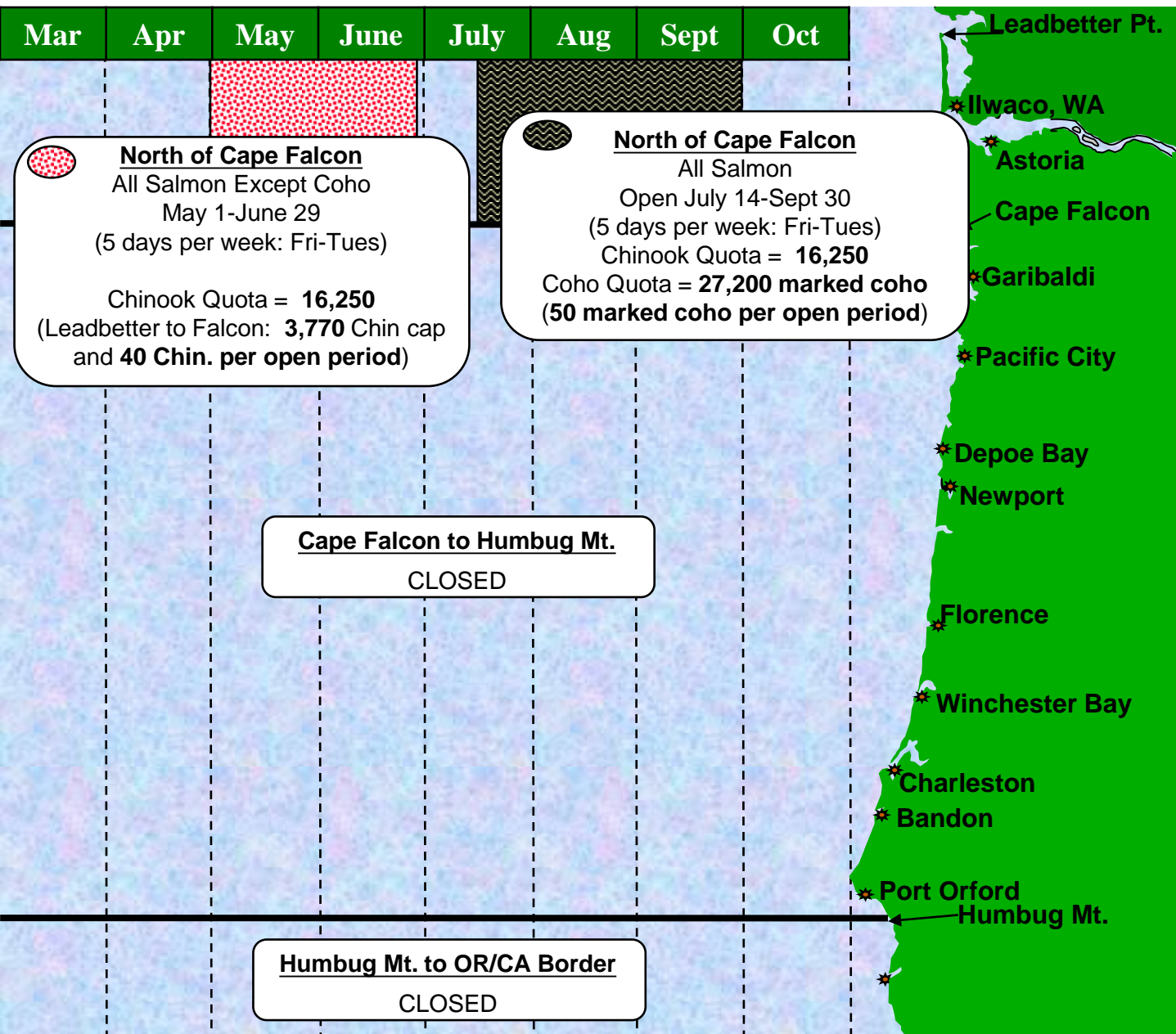

Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Chinook 27" minimum length. All landings into Oregon must be reported within one hour of landing at (541)857-2546 or to nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov **Open periods defined as Friday-Tuesday.**
