## Preliminary 2026 Oregon Ocean Recreational Salmon Estimates: Leadbetter Pt., WA and Cape Falcon, OR (Columbia River Catch Area)

Season: Open June 20 through earlier of September 30 or quota. Bag limit of two salmon per day, but no more than one Chinook, and all Coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. Min. lengths: Coho 16", Chinook 22", and steelhead 20". Coho quota: 51,450 Chinook guideline: 16,780. Columbia River Control Zone closed to salmon angling from a boat.
