

Guidance and Questions: Microsoft Teams for Pre-season Ocean Salmon Meeting

Instructions to Attendees:

- Keep video off unless speaking, it saves bandwidth and helps with connectivity for everyone.
- Raise hand feature (don't forget to also lower your hand after you have been recognized) – for some computers this is behind the “emoji” symbol in the menu options. If you can't find it, turn your video camera on and physically show a raised hand.
- The meeting and all chat comments will be recorded and are public record. Please keep chat comments and verbal comments respectful of all attendees and “G” rated. The recording posted to the ODFW Ocean Salmon website (<https://dfw.state.or.us/mrp/salmon/>) by the end of the week.
- All chat and comments should be directed to ODFW staff. Chat feature can be used to submit comments/questions – these will be read back to the whole group and generally can be viewed by all on-line attendees.
- Chats and raised hands will be monitored by staff and passed along to the current presenter and the group.
- We request that all participants stay muted until called on for comments/questions at the end of each presentation and during the recommendations phase of the meeting.
