

Yaquina Bay

Idaho Flat west access point

- Head south out of Newport on S Coast HWY/US-101 S.
- Go over the Newport bridge and turn right onto SW Abalone St.
- SW Abalone St becomes SE OSU Dr.
- SE OSU Dr. becomes SE Marine Science Dr.
- Travel 0.4 miles, at the roundabout turn right into the Hatfield Marine Science Visitors Center parking lot.
- Park and walk to the nature trail at the south end of the parking lot.
- Follow the nature trail around to the beach on the eastside the of Hatfield Marine Science buildings.

Idaho Flat east access point

- Head south out of Newport on S Coast HWY/US-101 S
- Go over the Newport bridge and turn left onto SE Ferry Slip Rd.
- Turn left to stay on SE Ferry Slip RD.
- Take 1st right onto SE 35th St.
- Travel 1.2 miles to a gravel pullout at the end of the road. Parking area is just before the Idaho Point Marine RV Park.
- From the pullout walk NW to access Idaho Flat. (This side of the flat can be very soft mud, watch your step!)

Bridge Bed access point

- Head south out of Newport on S Coast HWY/US-101 S.
- Go over the Newport Bridge and turn right onto SW Abalone St.
- SW Abalone St becomes SE OSU Dr.
- Turn left into the Rouge Brewery parking lot.
- Park and walk towards the bridge to access the clam beds.

Sally's Bend west access point

- Head east out of Newport on US-20 E/E Olive St.
- South right onto SE John Moore Rd.
- Travel 0.4 miles and turn left on SE Bay Blvd.
- SE Bay Blvd because Yaquina Bay Rd.
- Turn right onto Port Dock at the sign reading '1702 Yaquina Bay Rd'. Head towards the big green LNG tank.
- Park in the gravel parking lot at the end of the road and walk east down to the beach.

Sally's Bend east access point

- Head east out of Newport on US-20 E/E Olive St.
- Turn right on SE Benson RD.
- After 0.4 miles turn left onto Yaquina Bay RD.
- Follow the road around the bay for 2 miles.
- A parking area is on you right just west of SE Yaquina View Dr.
