Trout Stocking Sites

South Willamette Watershed District Lane, Linn, Marion and Polk Counties



ALTON BAKER POND On I-5, 1/2 mile from downtown Eugene on the north bank of the Willamette River.

BIG CLIFF RESERVOIR -150 acres on the North Santiam River. Big Cliff is located several miles below Detroit dam off of Hwy 22.

BLUE RIVER RESERVOIR - Forty-two miles east of Eugene off Highway 126.

BREITENBUSH RIVER- A tributary to Detroit Reservoir, it enters the reservoir at the town of Detroit

CARMEN RESERVOIR- On the upper McKenzie River, about 2 miles south of Clear Lake on Hwy. 126, 21 miles north of the McKenzie Hwy.

CLEAR LAKE - Seventy miles east of Eugene off Hwy 126.

COTTAGE GROVE POND - A group of 6 ponds totaling 15 acres. Located 1.5 miles east of Cottage Grove on Row River Road behind the truck scales.

COTTAGE GROVE RESERVOIR - Six miles south of Cottage Grove on London Road.

CRESWELL POND - From I-5, take the Creswell exit south along the east side of the freeway.

DETROIT RESERVOIR – A state park located 50 miles east of Salem, off Hwy 22 approximately 2 miles west of Detroit. The town of Detroit is near the upper (east) end of the lake.

DEXTER RESERVOIR – On I-5 15 miles SE of Eugene. Exit to Hwy 58, then head east to Dexter reservoir.

DORENA RESERVOIR – Seven miles east of Cottage Grove on Row River Road.

EAST FREEWAY LAKE – A 10-acre pond located 2.5 miles north of Hwy 34 and I-5 interchange. Take exit heading east on Hwy 34 then take Seven-Mile Lane north for 2.5 miles.

EE WILSON POND – 10 miles north of Corvallis on Highway 99W between Corvallis and Monmouth. The pond is in the E.E. Wilson Wildlife Management Area of Camp Adair.

FALL CREEK - Fifteen miles southeast of Springfield.

FOSTER RESERVOIR - A 1,200-acre reservoir near the town of Foster, about 3 miles east of Sweet Home, north of Highway 20.

GREEN PETER RESERVOIR – A 3,700-acre reservoir 10 miles east of Sweet Home and Foster, north of Hwy 20.

HILLS CREEK – Five miles southeast of Oakridge.

JUNCTION CITY PONDS – An 8-acre pond west side of Hwy 99, 3 miles south of Junction City. .9 miles south of Hwy 36 junction.

LEABURG LAKE – The lake is the body of water immediately above Leaburg Dam on the McKenzie River approximately 17 miles east of Springfield.

MCKENZIE RIVER LOWER AND UPPER – East of Eugene and Springfield along Highway 126.

MIDDLE FORK WILLAMETTE RIVER – Below Dexter Dam

QUARTZVILLE CREEK – From Hwy. 20 at Sweet Home, continue east to the upstream end of Forster Reservoir, then turn north (left) toward Sunnyside Campground crossing the northeast arm of Foster. Turn right on the Quartzville Rd., which follows the northern shore of Green Peter Reservoir, including the Quartzville Arm. Follow Quartzville Creek upstream more than 25 miles into Willamette National Forest (Forest Rd. 11).

ROARING RIVER PARK POND – A small pond in a day-use park near the Roaring River Fish Hatchery. From I-5 Albany area take exit 223 (Hwy 20 east), go 6 miles and turn left on to Highway 226, go 4 miles and turn right on Fish Hatchery Drive, go 8 miles.

SALT CREEK – Along Hwy 58 east of the City of Oakridge.

SALMON CREEK – Follow Hwy. 58 east from Springfield through Oakridge to the Salmon Creek Fish Hatchery one mile east of town to Forest Rd. 24.

SILVER CREEK RESERVOIR – A 65-acre reservoir on Silver Creek 2.5 miles south to Silverton on Hwy 214.

SMITH RESERVOIR - Reservoir is located on Hwy 126 approximately 70 miles east of Springfield. From Trail Bridge Reservoir turn north on Forest Road 730 which ends at Smith Dam.

ST. LOUIS PONDS From I-5 take Woodburn exit west to Gervais Rd, go south and then west on Jenson Rd. Ponds are left of the railroad. From 99E turn west on Douglas Rd. N.E approximately 2.5 miles to Tesch LN. NE. turn left on gravel road for 1 mile.

SUNNYSIDE POND – An 8-acre pond above Foster reservoir 3 miles east of Sweet Home off Quartzville Creek Rd.

TIMBER LINN LAKE – An 11-acre pond in Albany City Park at the east edge of Albany.

TRAIL BRIDGE RESERVOIR – 60 miles east of Springfield. The reservoir is about 14 miles northeast of McKenzie Bridge off Hwy. 126.

WALLING POND – Old gravel pit within Salem City limits west of I-5. Take Turner Road off Mission St (Mission St. is Hwy 22 exit off I-5)

WALTER WIRTH LAKE – East of Salem within Cascade Gateway Park. West of I-5 at Hwy 22. Take Airport Rd or Turner Rd to reach the lake.

WAVERLY LAKE – 5 acres north of Albany along Hwy. 99 E.
