BEACH USE



A Wildlife Treasure

Willow Bar Beach (clothed)

Located at milepost 7 on Reeder Road. Turn right at Multnomah and Columbia County line.

Beach length: two miles

Walton Beach (clothed)

Located at milepost 9.8 on Reeder Road.

Beach length: one mile.

Collins Beach (clothing-optional)

Located at milepost 11 on Reeder Road, one-quarter mile north of the end of pavement.

Beach length: one mile.

Clothing optional users: Please stay within the posted boundaries of Collins Beach (1400 feet south of private property signs) - you do not want to lose the privilege to use this beach.

North Unit Beach (clothed)

Located at milepost 13 on Reeder Road, two and one-quarter miles north of the end of pavement.

Beach length: three miles.

Regulations

Please obey Sauvie Island Wildlife Area Regulations for your safety and wildlife habitat protection.

- No open fires are allowed.
- All dogs must be on leashes and under control of owner.
- No motor-powered vehicles are allowed on beaches except emergency or service vehicles.
- Discharge of firearms is allowed only during authorized hunting seasons.

Hours

Sauvie Island Wildlife Area Beaches are open from 4 AM to 10 PM every day.

Parking Revenue

Parking permit revenue provides for services at the beaches. These include law enforcement, toilets, litter patrols and maintenance.

Enforcement

Beaches are patrolled daily by Columbia County, Multnomah County, Oregon State Police and Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.
