Degree and Timing of Risk

- Landowner capacity- knowledge, skills, resources
- Partnership with Natural Resource Conservation Service, Soil and Water Conservation District or other agency to plan and implement work on-site

- Overlap with ODFW mapped conservation areas- within or adjacent to [Conservation Opportunity Areas](#), within or adjacent to [Priority Wildlife Connectivity Areas](#)
- Proximity to existing conservation lands or public lands in the [Protected Areas Database](#)
- Documented presence of Conservation Strategy Species or Federally listed species from [Compass report](#)

Best Management Practices

- Invasive species management needs to be in the plan
- Fire management, as appropriate needs to be in the plan
- No grazing within the riparian corridor
- No ATV use in the WHCMP

Criteria Exceptions- Exceptions will be considered by agency staff on a case-by-case basis. For small properties, they must have an extraordinary attribute (i.e. amphibian migration corridor/breeding pond, bat hibernation roost, etc.), or be adjacent to protected or intact old growth habitat.
