



**Wildlife/Beaver Intern (near La Grande)**  
**Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife**

**Location:** Wallowa-Whitman National Forest (near La Grande/Baker City) - 1 position  
Housing will be provided. Weekly camping is expected.

**Pay Rate:** \$19.77 - \$22.23 per hour

**Duration:** Not to exceed 400 hours (10 weeks) June 15 – September 1, 2025

**Job Description:** This position will assist ODFW regional wildlife staff and the Powder Basin Watershed Council in beaver research and habitat improvements in the North Fork Burnt River watershed. The intern will lead a Northwest Youth Corps youth crew in beaver restoration work such as constructing buck and pole fences and installing Beaver Dam Analogs. Opportunities may also be available to assist regional wildlife staff with their daily duties.

**Duties:**

- Lead a Northwest Youth Corps youth crew
- Collect field habitat measurements
- Conduct beaver/habitat surveys
- Implement habitat improvement projects for beaver
- Assist ODFW regional wildlife and watershed council staff with daily work

Candidates should be able to work independently, including in a remote or field setting. Experience operating power equipment, driving an ATV, and pulling a trailer is preferred.

**Working Conditions:** Frequently work outside during inclement weather (hot, cold, wet), required to work before and after daylight (at times), camping in remote areas is required.
