



**Wildlife/Beaver Intern (near La Grande)**

**Location:** Union and Baker Counties (near La Grande/Baker City)  
Housing will be provided. Weekly camping may be required.

**Pay:** \$19.77 - \$22.23 hour

Note: this position will receive a Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) increase of 2.5% which is not reflected in the salary listed in this posting. The effective date of the increase is February 1, 2026.

**Duration:** Not to exceed 400 hours (10 weeks) between May 2026 – September 2026

**Job Description:** This position will assist the Powder Basin Watershed Council in conducting habitat and flow permanence surveys for pre- and post-project beaver restoration sites and ODFW regional wildlife staff with their daily duties.

**Duties:**

- Collect field habitat measurements (25%)
- Conduct habitat surveys (25%)
- Assist ODFW regional wildlife and watershed council staff with daily work (50%)

Candidates should be able to work independently, including in a remote or field setting. Experience driving an ATV, hiking, navigating in the field, and collecting scientific data in the field is preferred.

**Working Conditions:** Frequently work outside during inclement weather (hot, cold, wet), required to work before and after daylight (at times), camping in remote areas is required.
