## **Affidavit for Holding of Grandfathered Species**

In accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule 635, Division 044, a person who legally held grandfathered bears, cougars, bobcats, wolves, raccoons, skunks, squirrels, and chipmunks or other nongame species in Oregon on January 20, 2017 may continue to hold those animal(s) for the remainder of the animal(s) life, provided: the species had been acquired from a legally propagated out-of-state source with approved documentation such as a valid sales receipt, Certificate of Veterinary Inspection with import permit from Oregon Department of Agriculture, agency transfer of ownership permit identifying the animal was propagated and born in legal captivity, removed legally from the wild or as approved by the Department.
