NOTE: All applicable portions of the application must be completed. Incomplete applications will be returned. Renewal of permit and payment of associated fees must occur before the expiration date of the current permit. Verification of annual permit requirements (if applicable to the permit) must accompany the renewal application. A new application is required for any change of address by the permittee. The addition of animals of the species approved on the original permit requires prior approval.

- Raccoons and skunks must be acquired from an out-of-state licensed USDA breeder. Please include with your application a valid sales receipt, valid agency transfer of ownership permit identifying the animal was propagated and born in legal captivity, or other documentation as approved by the Department.

- A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection with import permit from Oregon Department of Agriculture is needed to legally import the animal into Oregon.

- A unique permanent marker number is required for each animal. The location (lip or ear tattoo and/or implanted RFID [radio frequency identification device]) and unique fur color/description or other identifying marks must be provided to the Department within 30 days of permit issuance. Please provide on lines below:

- Provide additional animal identification information including fur color or unique markings, ear tags, etc. for each animal. (Attach additional sheets if necessary):

- Raccoons and skunks may not be offered for sale, trade, barter, or exchange as a household pet (ORS 498.029) and may not be bred, reproduced or propagated. Provide documentation of sterilization if requesting to hold two or more raccoons or skunks of different sexes.

- Provide documentation that caging for raccoon meets the standards defined in the Oregon Enclosure and Caging Standards for Holding Wildlife (Exhibit 1). Facility inspection may be required before possession of animal.
