INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Complete application and sign.
- 2) Check the appropriate box for the raptor you wish to capture. Falconer can check more than one box, but the permit is valid for only one raptor. If a band is required for a particular species and the band is not used, it must be returned by February 28 of the current capture season.
This permit would become invalid:
 - a) Once the falconer has reached his/her limit for annual take,
 - b) If the falconer's total wild take maximum is reached (based on the associated falconry class as listed in Oregon Administrative Rules), or
 - c) If the quota for a particular species is reached, then capture season is closed and this permit cannot be used for those species.
